IMPORTANT REMINDERS AS WE START THE YEAR...

Supervision at School Please remember that playground supervision at school commences at 8.20am and concludes at 3.30pm. For safety reasons, children should not be at school before or after these times.

School Starting Time School starts at 8.50am. Children need to be at school by ten to nine so they can have a play and socialise with their friends and go to the toilet before lessons start.

If your child is absent from school If your child/ren are away from school, please send an explanation note with your child when they return to school, absent notes can also be sent in via the skoolbag app. If no explanation is received then your child is marked as an unexplained absence.

If your child arrives late or leaves early If your child/ren arrive late for school, you need to bring them into the office and sign them in. If you need to collect your child early from school, you must visit the office and sign an early leave form. If you know in advance your child will be leaving early then please send a note to the teacher.

Afternoon Collection For those parents collecting children from under the COLA in the afternoons you are kindly asked not to sit on or allow toddlers to play on the prayer space near the office steps. Please wait in the area close to the building.

Holiday Exemption Forms If your child/ren will be away from school for 10 days or more, you are required to send a letter to Mr Blissenden requesting exemption prior to the leave date. We will then forward the appropriate paperwork to you to complete and return to school. Once approved we will send you the exemption form that you are required to carry with you whilst you are away.
