

#### PRE-LOVED CLOTHING POOL



Here's a quick reminder of what the each Year Group should wear for the concert:

GRADE	COSTUME IDEAS
KINDER	Plain coloured t-shirts (black, yellow, brown or orange) shorts.
YEAR 1	Bethlehem people: Jeans/shorts and a plain t-shirt.
YEAR 2	<b>Shepherds:</b> Long robe type clothing with a waist tie. Tea towel with rope for headgear.
YEAR 3	<b>Angels:</b> White t-shirt and red or green or denim shorts. Halos made with tinsel.
YEAR 4	<b>People from the Old Testament:</b> Plain red, green or yellow t- shirts or a Christmas shirt. Shorts or jeans.
YEAR 5	Kings: Black jeans, pants, skirts or shorts. Yellow t-shirt.
YEAR 6	Innkeepers: Jeans or shorts. Plain white, brown or black shirt.
