Message from Parramatta City Council - Council, in conjunction with Spot Parking Finder, have developed an online portal which outlines the parking restrictions outside all Primary Schools in the City of Parramatta Local Government Area for any given time in the day. This portal is designed to be used as a *pre-planning tool* for parents, grand-parents or guardians to park safely and legally near their child's school, particularly during drop off and pick up times. It is not available as an 'app' as we do not want to encourage or appear to endorse the use of a mobile phone whilst driving, nor provide the temptation! In the coming weeks Council Officers will be handing out the attached pamphlet when conducting school safety patrols in an effort to encourage parents to use the site and become familiar with the parking restrictions around their school.
